Statement-Petition

Concerning the Draft Law on the Principles of State Language Policy

The Canadian Conference in Support of Ukraine expresses its resolute protest against the adoption of the first reading to the draft law on the Principles of State Language Policy that took place in the Parliament of Ukraine on June 5, 2012.

The efforts to force through this legislation introduced by MPs Kolesnichenko and Kivalov from the Party of Regions is yet another anti-Ukrainian and anti-state provocation by the authorities.

The goal of this provocation is to create divisions in society on the eve of the parliamentary elections and thereby divert the attention of the electorate away from the authoritarian and corrupt regime.
