| OSCE assessment | According to the monitoring of the state of protection of Ukrainian ethnic minority's rights in Russia and Russian ethnic minority's rights in Ukraine held in March – April 2009, Office of the OSCE High Commissioner on National Minorities noted that conditions for securing cultural and linguistic rights of Russian national minority in Ukraine are estimated as significantly better than average conditions provided to the national minorities by the OSCE member-states. | |
