BACKGROUND

Eight years ago, Russia annexed Ukraine's Crimean Peninsula and invaded a large swathe of Eastern Ukraine to support a non-existent 'separatist movement'.

As a result of this aggression thousands have died and millions require humanitarian aid.

Since 2014, people living in Donbas have lived in fear. "Fear of the physical violence caused by the conflict surrounding them. Fear about whether or not they will earn enough money or be able to access pensions to support themselves. Fear of living close to the 'contact line', which is littered with landmines and other explosives."

To shine a light on the human dimension, we have compiled updated statistics based on official sources so that the true impact of Russian aggression can be known.
